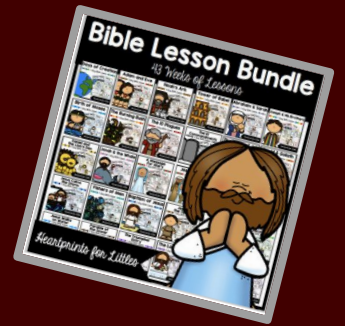

Students may carry a backpack or a tote bag with shoulder straps.

Potty Policy

All students must be toilet-trained. Although accidents may happen now and then, this should be an exception and not a frequent occurrence. The definition of school potty-trained is different from the definition of home/daycare potty-trained. Students should not depend on adults to read body language or have to be prompted to take care of potty needs.

1. Child goes to the restroom without prompting.
2. The child can pull down/up underwear/pants without help.
3. Child can wipe with no help.
4. Teachers can help with snaps/buttons/zippers.
5. Child goes to the restroom without prompting.

Nap mats and/or bags can be purchased through Little MA Primary. They will be available at Orientation, Monday, August 5th. The cost, \$30, will be added to your child's account. If your child already has a cloth nap mat, snap a picture and email to Mrs. Jodi for approval. Because of storage, nap mats cannot be too fluffy. You may purchase a bag to carry the nap mat for \$5.

Sleep Buddies



Your child's teacher will determine if your child may bring a **SMALL** sleeping buddy for rest time. If allowed, help your child choose a buddy that is soft, quiet, and designed for sleep with rather than play.



LUNCH

If bringing lunch from home, open difficult to open food or place food in a ziplock bag/easy to open container. You may also choose to pack food in a compartmentalized container. Do not send food that requires microwaving. Place hot food in a thermos or wrap in foil to keep warm. We do not want to risk burning a child.



SNACK

Place a healthy snack in your child's bag daily. Some parents choose to put 5 snacks in the tote bag and let the child pick one each day. Candy is not considered a healthy snack. Children will drink water from a spill-proof water bottle with their name clearly marked. Please place snacks in the tote bag not in the lunchbox so snack will not be eaten at lunch time.
